## VEHICLE BURGLARIES/ATTEMPT BURGLARIES

**DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE:** Friday, May 8, 2009—Saturday, May 9, 2009 in the late evening hours

**LOCATION:** G9 Parking Structure, east side of campus near Zelzah Avenue

**REPORTED OFFENSE:** One vehicle burglary and two attempt vehicle burglaries occurred in the late evening hours between Friday May 8 and Saturday May 9, 2009. Suspect(s) took electronic equipment from one vehicle. Attempts to two other vehicles were made by prying the door locks.

**SUSPECT DESCRIPTION/SUSPECT VEHICLE:** No suspect or vehicle was seen.

### CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

**Do not leave valuable/electronic property in your vehicle** - do not leave valuable property in plain view. Take the items with you or lock them in the trunk.

**Program CSUN Police numbers into your phone** - Within the CSUN community the university police can respond to emergencies much faster than other local law enforcement. CSUN PD dispatch- (818) 677-2111. LAPD may be called for off-campus emergencies (818) 832-0586.

**Utilize the emergency blue light phones** to report emergencies or crimes in progress to CSUN police. There are over 60 emergency phones throughout campus. Use these phones to be automatically connected to CSUN police dispatchers in the event of a police, fire or medical emergency.

**Be a good witness** - If you observe a crime in progress **call the police immediately!** Describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as gender, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, etc. Try to get the license plate if a vehicle is involved.
