Modeling / Extortion Scam

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE: March 14-15, 2009

LOCATION: Athletic fields

Lance Elliott Williams (pictured) was seen on the CSUN campus in violation of a stay-away order issued by the Los Angeles Superior Court in October 2008. Williams has contacted female athletes to rouse them into a modeling scam which involves solicitation of sex/extortion.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION:

Lance Elliot Williams; 30 years old; male black, 5'11", 150 lbs.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: Unknown

TAKE A STAND AGAINST CRIME

Program CSUN Police numbers into your phone - Within the CSUN community the university police can respond to emergencies much faster than other local law enforcement. CSUN PD dispatch- (818) 677-2111. LAPD may be called for off-campus emergencies (818) 832-0586.

Utilize the emergency blue light phones to report emergencies or crimes in progress to CSUN police. There are over 60 emergency phones throughout campus. Use these phones to be automatically connected to CSUN police dispatchers in the event of a police, fire or medical emergency.

Be a good witness - If you observe a crime in progress **call the police immediately!** Describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as gender, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars. Try to get the license plate if a vehicle is involved.
