CAMPUS CRIME ALERT

The California State University, Northridge Police Department is providing this notice of a criminal incident that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding a similar crime or provide information to solve this crime.

STRONG ARM ROBBERY (OFF CAMPUS INCIDENT)

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE: Monday, February 18th 2008
between 9:35 p.m. & 9:55 p.m.

LOCATION: Etiwanda Avenue & Kinzie Street

REPORTED OFFENSE: On February 18th 2008 at approximately 9:35 p.m., a CSUN student was walking on Etiwanda towards Kinzie when she was confronted by the suspect. The suspect demanded the victim's property before taking it. He then ran to a nearby vehicle (described as a newer model white Chrysler 300). The suspect, with an unknown driver, were seen leaving the area westbound on Kinzie Street from Etiwanda Avenue. The victim was not injured during this incident. The suspects are still outstanding.

SUSPECT #1: Male black or Hispanic, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, (with the hood covering his face) and dark pants.

SUSPECT #2 (Driver): Male unknown.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: Off-white, New model Chrysler 300 (similar to stock photo)



A similar incident occurred last Monday, February 11th near parking lot D6 in which a student was confronted by three male blacks who demanded and stole his personal property. The three suspects were seen leaving the area in a white Chrysler 300.

TAKE A STAND AGAINST CRIME

Be aware of your surroundings and avoid being distracted by phone calls or head phones/ear buds.

Park in well lit and busy areas, close to entrances/exits and travel in groups or use the Matador Patrol Safety Escort Service (818) 677-5042/5048.

Be a good witness and call police if you see a crime in progress - describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as gender, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars. Try to get the license plate if a vehicle is involved.

Program CSUN Police numbers into your phone - In the event of a police, fire or medical emergency dial: **9-1-1 from a campus phone** or **(818) 677-2111 from a cell phone**. **NOTE:** Calling 911 from a cell phone will not direct you to CSUN Police.
